

**Prefers to die rather than to humble themselves – lacks sympathy but has a great capacity for reason – may be said to have two heads but no heart (war, torture, death, concentration camps meant little to Stalin, Mao, Lenin, Hitler, Alexander the Great, Napoleon and other great Choleric)

**Cannot tolerate false sympathy, touchy-feely caresses or sentimentality – even among close family or friends, which can cause them to appear cruel, hard, heartless or indifferent to the sufferings of others – yet this trait is an advantage in that it helps them stay focused on a goal

**Cannot be without work, challenges or the opportunity to be in authority

****Advice****

***They must check themselves daily to be sure they have been kind and considerate to those who may be sick, tired or elderly – they should seek opportunities to show love, humility, forgiveness and learn to listen more than they speak

***Must learn not to promote themselves and consider the needs of others – LISTEN!!

***They must make a conscious effort to cultivate humility and keep a rein on pride and anger

***Never try to 'break' a Choleric's will (they will get hard and bitter) – gently suggest reasonable alternatives – remain calm and let them "cool off" and then encourage them to seek guidance so faults can be corrected and his/her talents used to their best advantage

***Place high ideas before them – appeal to their sense of honor – but be firm and don't back down

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
